



10 Things to Have On Hand for Your New Kitten

1. 2 litter boxes- you should have 1 more litter box than the number of cats in the household. Place the litter boxes in quiet, out of the way places.
2. The litter should not have baking soda in it. The baking soda fizzes when your cat pees and it thinks it's another cat hissing at them.
3. High quality kitten food. Royal Canin, Wellness, Science Diet, Nutro Natural Choice, and Innova are all good brands.
4. High quality treats for training- Innova, Wellness
5. Quiet place to rest- kitty condo, bed, etc.
6. Glass bowls- cats can be allergic to plastic or metal
7. Toys- cat dancer, birdie flyer, etc.
8. Cat nip
9. Laser light
